Family leaders are passionate, determined, and dedicated to improving outcomes for children, youth, and families.

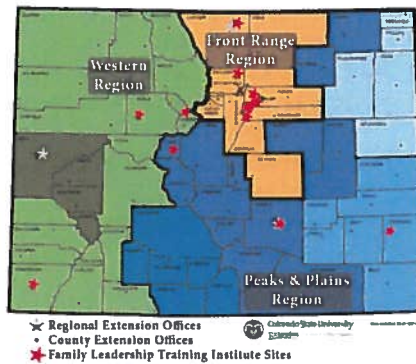

FLTI is offered in communities across Colorado. Some classes are offered in monolingual Spanish and some classes are offered to youth (in addition to adults).

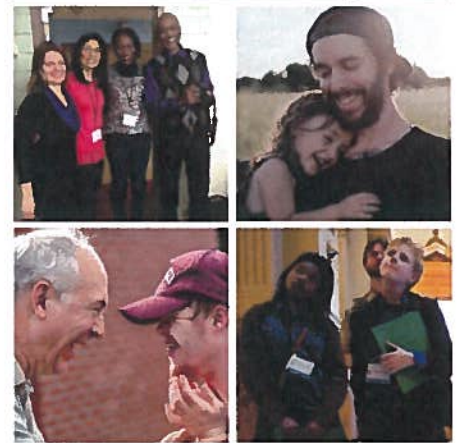
